APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 2022-02-042

"AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING/AUGMENTING THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (P150,000.00) FROM THE APPROPRIATION FOR DRUGS AND MEDICINE EXPENSES UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE MUNICIPAL HEALTH OFFICER TO PRINTING AND BINDING EXPENSES OF THE SAME OFFICE."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF SAN PABLO, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

- Section 1. There is an appropriation for Drugs and Medicine Expenses under the office of the Municipal Health Officer for FY 2022 amounting Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P2,500,000.00);
- Section 2. The total amount of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (P150,000.00) shall be augmented to the appropriation for Printing and binding Expenses of the same office.
- Section 3. Transfer/Augment of Item. The Local Chief Executive or the Presiding Officer of the Sanggunian concerned, may by ordinance, be authorized to augment any item in the approved annual budget for their respective offices from savings in other items within the same expense class of their respective appropriations, (Art. 454 of RA 7160).
- **Section 4.** Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after approval by the Sangguniang Bayan.
