RESOLUTION NO. 20140697

"A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MAYOR, HON. BELMAN B. MANTOS TO ENTER INTO MOA WITH THE DILG FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE GPBP PROCESS".

WHEREAS, to pursue the Millennium Development Goal (MDG) of reducing poverty, the government launched the GPBP project;

WHEREAS, the municipality of San Pablo, Zamboanga del Sur, after endorsing the Local Poverty Reduction Action Plan (LPRAP), was identified by the NAPC, DSWD, DILG and DBM as one of the 609 pilot LGU's to implement the Grassroots Participatory Budgeting and Planning (GPBP) Process;

WHEREAS, the LGU San Pablo understands fully the terms and conditions set in the agreement and will operate and maintain properly the facility provided under the project and shall appropriate funds for the maintenance and operation of the completed facility.

WHEREFORE, on motion by Hon. Roberto M. Aguilar, duly seconded by Hon. Jeffrey P. Cordero, be it

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolve, authorizing the Municipal Mayor, Hon. Belman B. Mantos to enter into Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Department of Interior and local Government (DILG) for the implementation of the GPBP Process.




