EXCERPT FROM THE MINUTES OF THE 1ST REGULAR SESSION OF THE 11TH MUNICIPAL COUNCIL (Under the Local Government Code of 1991) HELD AT THE MULTI-PURPOSE BUILDING, SAN PABLO, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR ON JULY 13, 2022.

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-03

"A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HON. MUNICIPAL MAYOR, DANILO A. TAUCAN, REPRESENTING THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF SAN PABLO, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR, TO ENTER INTO MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGY (DICT) AND FOR THE ADOPTION/IMPLEMENTATION OF THE IBPLS: BUSINESS PERMIT WITH BARANGAY CLEARANCE, BUILDING PERMIT AND CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY MODULES".

WHEREAS, the Ibpls: Business Permit with Barangay Clearance, Building Permit and Certificate of Occupancy Modules are being deployed by the Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT) in collaboration with the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) to recognize good governance performance in the adoption of good local governance;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of San Pablo is one of the recipients of the IBPLS: Business Permit with Barangay Clearance, Building Permits and Certificate of Occupancy Modules;

WHEREAS, upon thorough review of the terms and conditions of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA), the same are found to be in order;

WHEREAS, Section 8.3.1 (c) of the Anti-Red Tape Authority ("ARTA"), Department of Trade and Industry ("DTI"), Department of Interior and Local Government ("DILG"), and Department of Information and Communications Technology ("DICT") JOINT Memorandum Circular no. 01, s. of 2016, Re: Guidelines for Processing Business Permits, Related Clearances, and Licenses in all Cities and Municipalities, encouraged LGUs without eBOSS to utilize the DICT's Ibpls.

WHEREAS, Section 11 (c) of the EODB Law mandates all cities and municipalities to automate their Business permitting and licensing system or set up an electronic Business One-Stop-Shop.

WHEREAS, Section 7.2 of the Department of Trade and Industry ("DTI"), Department of Interior and Local Government ("DILG"), and Department of Information and Communications Technology ("DICT"), and Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) Joint Memorandum Circular no. 01, s. 2018, Re: Guidelines in Streamlining the Process for the Issuance of Building Permits and Certificates of Occupancy, encouraged LGUs to set up a One-Stop Shop for construction Permits (OSCP).

WHEREAS, in compliance to the foregoing, the DICT is implementing the Integrated Business Permits and Licensing System ("IBPLS") Project, the CBP Project, and the PBD Project (said projects shall hereinafter be collectively referred to as "Covered Projects. "The Systems under the Covered Projects shall hereinafter be collectively referred to as "Covered Systems");

WHEREAS, the LGU manifested its interest to computerize and automate the processing of the applications for business permits and licenses, and has decided to participate in the implementation of the IBPLS, CBP, and PBD Projects of the DICT;

WHEREFORE, ON MOTION BY Hon. Jorge R. Gonzales, duly seconded by Hon. Artemio C. Dayondon, be it

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, **Authorizing the Hon. Municipal Mayor, Danilo A. Taucan, representing the Local Government Unit of San Pablo, Zamboanga Del Sur, to enter Into Memorandum Of Agreement (MOA) with the Department Of Information and Communications Technology (DICT) and for the Adoption/Implementation of the IBPLS: Business Permit with Barangay Clearance, Building Permit and Certificate of Occupancy Modules".**
