RESOLUTION NO. 2024-27

"A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MAYOR, HON. DANILO A. TAUCAN TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE PHILIPPINE BUSINESS FOR SOCIAL PROGRESS, INC. AS A PRINCIPAL RECIPIENT OF THE GLOBAL FUND GRANT TO FIGHT AIDS, TUBERCULOSIS, AND MALARIA FOR THE ADVANCEMENT OF CLIENT-CENTERED CARE AND EXPANSION OF SUSTAINABLE SERVICES FOR TB PROGRAM."

WHEREAS, the Global Fund has provided a grant to the Philippine business for Social Progress, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "PBSP") to combat the spread of AIDS, tuberculosis, and malaria;

WHEREAS, the Grant aims to enhance client-centered care and expand sustainable services for the Tuberculosis (TB) Program;

WHEREAS, the municipality of San Pablo recognizes the importance of supporting initiatives that promote public health, well-being, and the eradication of infectious diseases;

WHEREAS, it is crucial for the municipality to collaborate with PBSP as a Principal Recipient of the Global Fund grant to ensure effective implementation of the TB program;

WHEREAS, on order to formalize the terms of cooperation and to outline the respective roles, responsibilities, and obligations of both parties, a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) must be established.

WHEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Artemio C. Dayondon, severally seconded, be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, **AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MAYOR, HON. DANILO A. TAUCAN TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE PHILIPPINE BUSINESS FOR SOCIAL PROGRESS, INC.
